Everyday Programs

- Victorian Pleasures** (1 hour) Pre-K to Gr. 3
Teachers/chaperones use the Teacher Guides, previously sent to them, to tour their group around the Amédée Forget Museum. Also includes time in the Once Upon a Time Room.
- At Home with the Forgets** (1 hour) Gr. 3 to Gr. 6
Teachers/chaperones use the Teacher Guides, previously sent to them, to tour their group around the Amédée Forget Museum.
- It's Democracy** (1 ½ hours) Gr. 5 to Gr. 10
Following a visit to the Amédée Forget Museum and the J.E.N. Wiebe Interpretive Centre, students will play *It's Democracy* on a giant game board.

Additional Resources

Add on any of these fun and educational resources to a self-guided tour of the Amédée Forget Museum (using our wonderful interpretive panels located throughout the museum).

- Geocaching in the Garden** (1 hour) Gr. 5 to Gr. 12
Groups navigate around the Edwardian Gardens using a GPS (Global Positioning System) unit, answering clues and learning about the historical features around the gardens.
- Scavenger Hunts** (1 ½ hours) Pre-K to Gr. 8
Choose from outdoor or indoor scavenger hunts that will educate and excite your group!
- Whodunit?** (30 Minutes – October only) – Prekindergarten to Grade 4
This program is based on the book "Ghosts of Government House" by Judith Silverthorne. Throughout the house, find clues left behind by one of the ghosts of Government House. Which of the ghosts is leaving you clues and what is he looking for?
- Trivia with George** (20 minutes) – Grades 4 - 7
Learn more about the famous Government House gardener George Watt as you enjoy the lush environment of the Sylvia Fedoruk Conservatory. Teams will compete to answer questions while searching through excerpts from the daily journals George Watt kept during the early 1900s.
- Discovery Backpacks** (1 hour)
 - Explore the Crown – Amédée Forget Museum (Pre-K to Gr. 5)
Includes a scavenger hunt, seek & find book, create your own crown and much more!
 - Celebrate Canada – Edwardian Gardens (Gr. 2 to Gr. 5)
Includes a puzzle, Magnifying Trees Hunt, a compass, frisbee and much more!

Winter Programs

For both programs, teachers/chaperones use the Teacher Guides, previously sent to them, to tour their group around the Amédée Forget Museum. Because of the popularity of these programs the following start times are being offered: 9:15, 10:30, 1:15 or 2:00. They are each one-hour long.

- Twas the Night before Christmas** (1 hour) Pre-K to Gr. 2
Along with a tour of the museum, students get to play in the Once Upon a Time Room and decorate a gingerbread cookie, which they will take back to school and enjoy.
- A Gift of Christmas Past** (1 hour) Gr. 3 to Gr. 6
Along with a tour of the museum, students also get to do a craft and get a gingerbread cookie to take back to school and enjoy.
